Course Contents	In this course the following international judicial bodies will be investigated: International Criminal Court (ICC) and other international criminal courts AD HOC or hybrid international criminal courts (for example: the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY); International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda (ICTR)); Special Court for Sierra Leone (SCSL) ; besides; extradition proceedings, the rights of the defence and victim's rights.
