<b>Course Objectives</b>	The aim of the course is for students to learn the subject of constitutional law and the functioning of institutions, starting from the appearance of the first signs, the concept, meaning, sources and elaboration of numerous institutions and relations established by the constitution, as a basic and supreme act, but also their functional position in the realization of democracy, position of the citizen as a basic political subject in the society.
<b>Course Contents</b>	Within this course, the constitutional law of the Republic of Turkey will be studied, pointing out the specifics and common elements of the Constitution with modern constitutions and constitutional law. The development of Turkey's constitutionality, fundamental values, fundamental freedoms and civil rights, elections and democracy will also be the subject of study; Assembly of Turkey; President of the Republic, Government of Turkey; state administration, relations between the assembly and the executive, judiciary, defense, international relations and local self-government.
